## 2020 Primary Absentee Voting

### I don't have a printer, how can I request an absentee ballot?

You can call the Hamilton County Board of Elections 632-7000 and ask for an absentee application to be sent to you in the mail.

### Voters who can't obtain an absentee vote by mail application can write the following information on a blank sheet of paper:

- Your full name and date of birth
- Your current address in Ohio
- Address where your ballot should be mailed if different from your current address
- One of these: Ohio driver license number, last four of your social security number, or you can include a copy of acceptable form of ID (see [www.VoteOhio.gov](http://www.VoteOhio.gov))
- State that "I am a qualified elector and I'm requesting an absentee ballot for the March 17th Primary in Hamilton County"
- Indicate if you want a: Democratic, Republican, Libertarian, or Issues Only ballot (choose only one)

**Sign & date the statement** (you can also list your phone number and/or email address)
