IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR VOTERS

What should voters know?

- All polling locations will be open for voting from 6:30am – 7:30pm on Tuesday, March 17th. This includes polling locations that are in facilities (including libraries and schools, etc) that may be closed to normal business on that day.
- Twenty-six polling locations that were housed in residential senior citizen facilities were relocated to nearby polling locations. Signage redirecting voters to the new polling location will be placed at the former locations. Notices were mailed to voters affected by this change.
- Poll workers will be taking safety precautions with regard to washing their hands and disinfecting high touch areas

What should voters do?

- If available, bring your own hand sanitizer to use before and after voting
- You may choose to bring your own pen to mark your ballot. Black or blue ink only. No markers!
- Maintain social distancing as much as possible
- Confirm your polling location on our website or by calling the board of elections
