Types of Precinct Election Officials

Voting Location Manager (VLM): Pick up the supplies for the election on the Saturday before election day at location near the polling place; coordinate all activities at the polling place at the Organizational Meeting and throughout Election Day; report any problems to the Board of Elections; return the ballots and supplies to the Ballot Drop Off Location.

Voting Location Deputy (VLD): May pick up the supplies for the election on the Saturday before election day, will assist the VLM with responsibilities and procedures at the polling place; may accompany the VLM, in the same car, to the Ballot Drop Off location.

Precinct Election Official (PEO): Participate in all activities at the Organizational Meeting and on Election Day, assist the VLM and instruct each voter about the voting procedures at the polling place.
