- The last four digits of your social security number **OR**
- Your Ohio driver's license number or state ID card number: (2 letters & 6 numbers) **OR**
- A COPY of a different form of current photo identification (a driver's license, state ID card, or interim ID form issued by the Ohio BMV; a US passport or passport card; or a US military ID card, Ohio National Guard ID card, or US Department of Veterans Affairs ID card). The copy of the photo ID must include images of the **front and back**, except for a passport which must include the passport's identification page.

- I understand that, per Ohio law, the board of elections must receive this request no later than **8:30pm on October 31st, 2023.**
- I understand that if an absentee ballot is mailed to me and I change my mind and go to my polling place to vote on Election Day, I will be required to vote a provisional ballot.
- I understand that if I do not provide the board with all of the required information, my application cannot be processed.
- I hereby declare, under penalty of election falsification, that I am a qualified elector and the statements above are true.

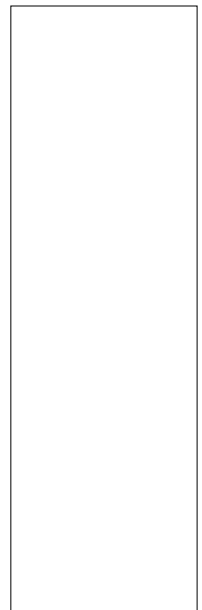

TO ENSURE YOUR ABSENTEE BALLOT REQUEST IS RECEIVED, PLEASE DO THE FOLLOWING:

- Complete all fields.
- Sign and date your application.
- Mail the completed application, or return using our 24-hour secure drop box at the Hamilton County Board of Elections, 4700 Smith Rd., Cincinnati, OH 45212. This form must be received by the Board of Elections by **8:30 p.m. on October 31st, 2023.**

NEXT STEPS

- Once the board of elections receives your absentee vote by mail application, the board will process your request and mail your ballot beginning **October 11th, 2023** to your address.
- You can track your application and your ballot online at votehamiltoncountyohio.gov
- If you return your absentee ballot by mail, it must be postmarked no later than **November 6th, 2023** and received by the board of elections no later than **November 11th, 2023**. By state law, a postmark does NOT include a date marked by a postage evidence system such as a postage meter.
- If you return your ballot to the board in person, or if a near relative* delivers it for you, the board of elections must receive your ballot no later than **7:30 p.m. on Election Day**.
- For members of the uniformed services or voters outside of the United States ONLY, ballots must be received by **November 11th, 2023**. Sign your identification envelope by the close of polls on Election Day or return in person by **7:30 p.m. on Election Day**.

**Near relative includes the voter's spouse or the voter's father, mother, father-in-law, mother-in-law, grandfather, grandmother, brother, or sister of the whole or half blood, or the son, daughter, adopting parent, adopted child, stepparent, stepchild, uncle, aunt, nephew, or niece.*
