- Issues Only (Available in Colerain Township, Miami Township (unincorporated areas), Whitewater Township, Cincinnati 18-B, Norwood 1-A, Norwood 3-B, Lockland B)

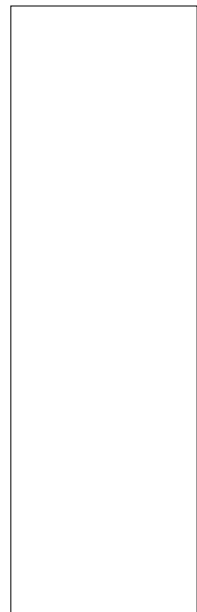
- I wish to vote in the Primary Election to be held **Tuesday, March 19, 2024.**
- I understand that, per Ohio law, the board of elections must receive this request no later than **8:30pm on March 12, 2024.**
- I understand that if an absentee ballot is mailed to me and I change my mind and go to my polling place to vote on Election Day, I will be required to vote a provisional ballot.
- I understand that if I do not provide the board with all of the required information, my application cannot be processed.
- I hereby declare, under penalty of election falsification, that I am a qualified elector and the statements above are true.

## TO ENSURE YOUR ABSENTEE BALLOT REQUEST IS RECEIVED, PLEASE DO THE FOLLOWING:

- Complete all fields.
- Sign and date your application.
- Mail the completed application, or return using our 24-hour secure drop box at the Hamilton County Board of Elections, 4700 Smith Rd., Cincinnati, OH 45212. This form must be received by the Board of Elections by **8:30pm on March 12, 2024**.

## NEXT STEPS

- Once the board of elections receives your absentee vote by mail application, the board will process your request and mail your ballot beginning **February 21<sup>st</sup>, 2024** to your address.
- You can track your application and your ballot online at [votehamiltoncountyohio.gov](https://votehamiltoncountyohio.gov)
- If you return your absentee ballot by mail, it must be postmarked no later than **March 18<sup>th</sup>, 2024** and received by the board of elections no later than **March 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2024**. By state law, a postmark does NOT include a date marked by a postage evidence system such as a postage meter.
- If you return your ballot to the board in person, or if a near relative\* delivers it for you, the board of elections must receive your ballot no later than **7:30 p.m. on Election Day**.
- For members of the uniformed services or voters outside of the United States ONLY, ballots must be received by **March 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2024**. Sign your identification envelope by the close of polls on Election Day or return in person by **7:30 p.m. on Election Day**.

*\*Near relative includes the voter's spouse or the voter's father, mother, father-in-law, mother-in-law, grandfather, grandmother, brother, or sister of the whole or half blood, or the son, daughter, adopting parent, adopted child, stepparent, stepchild, uncle, aunt, nephew, or niece.*
