- Youth at the Booth high school students (age 17+) are eligible to gain first-hand experience in our democratic process by working as poll workers.

- <u>Devoted to Service</u> participating nonprofits recruit volunteers to be poll workers. They pledge to donate their pay to the nonprofit. A great way to raise money for your cause!
- <u>Second Call to Duty</u> Veterans of the Armed Services are invited to a Second Call to Duty by working the polls to ensure free and fair elections.
- <u>CLE with the BOE</u> one of the Board's most successful programs, CLE with the BOE, allows attorneys to earn FREE Continuing Legal Education credits plus compensation for their time.
